

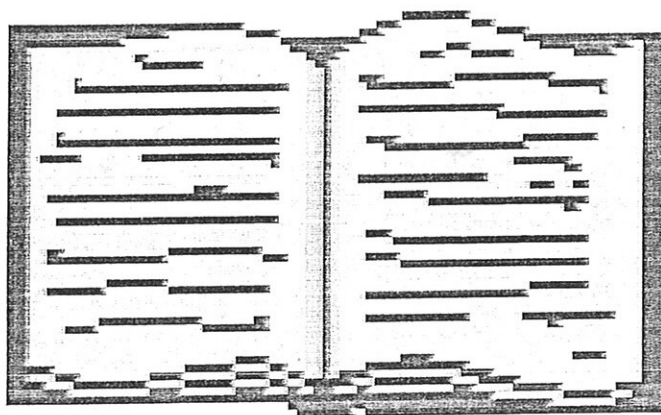
The mitten

went

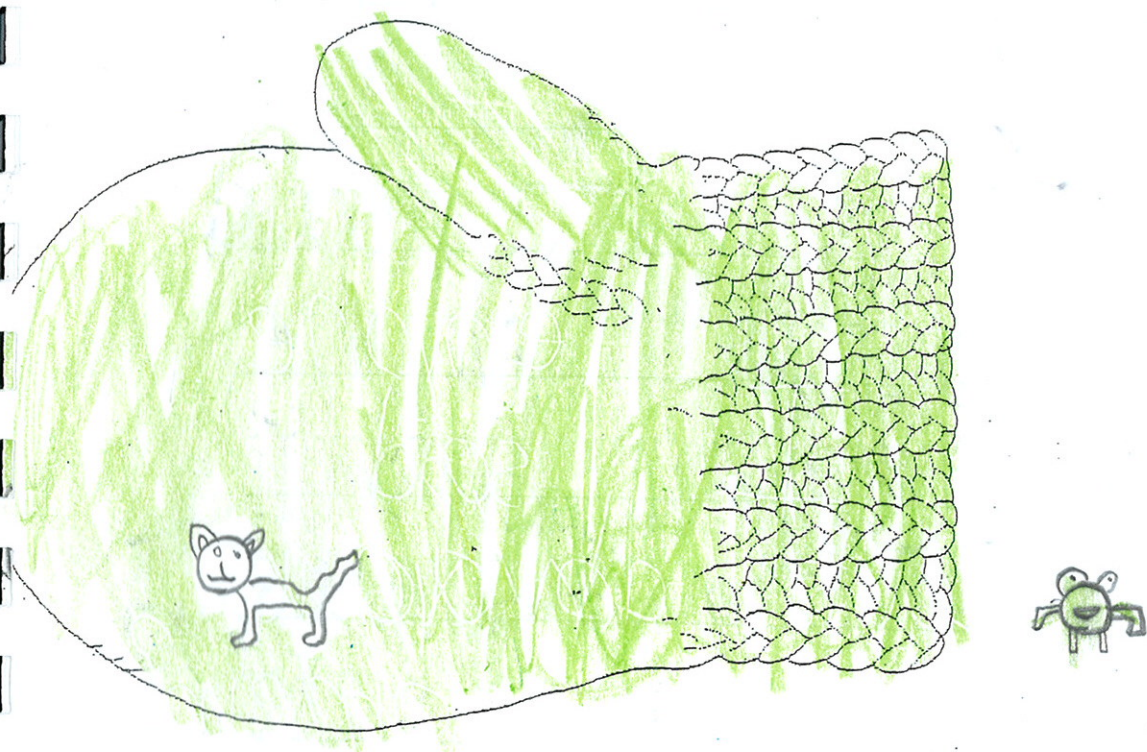


her mitten was gone.

home! I found

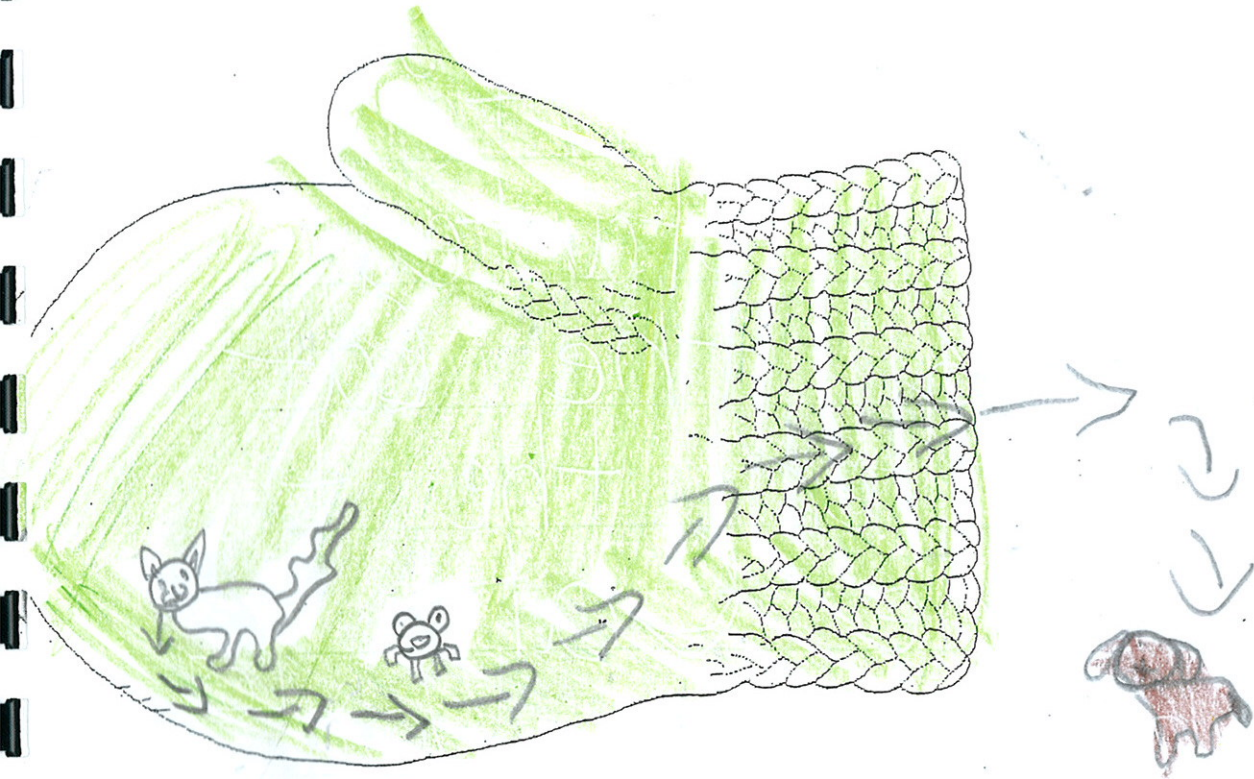
a home! I am
